# Hornell School District Poverty Level

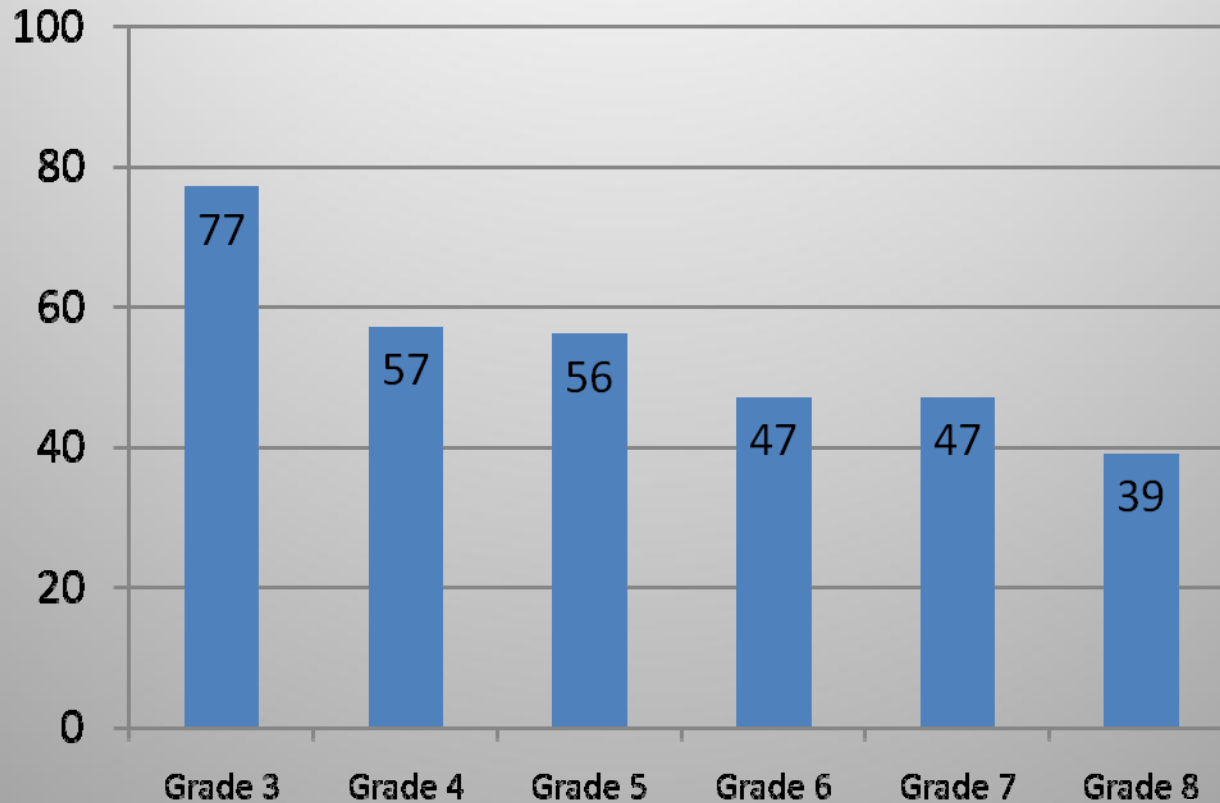

# NYS ELA Assessments (2005-06)

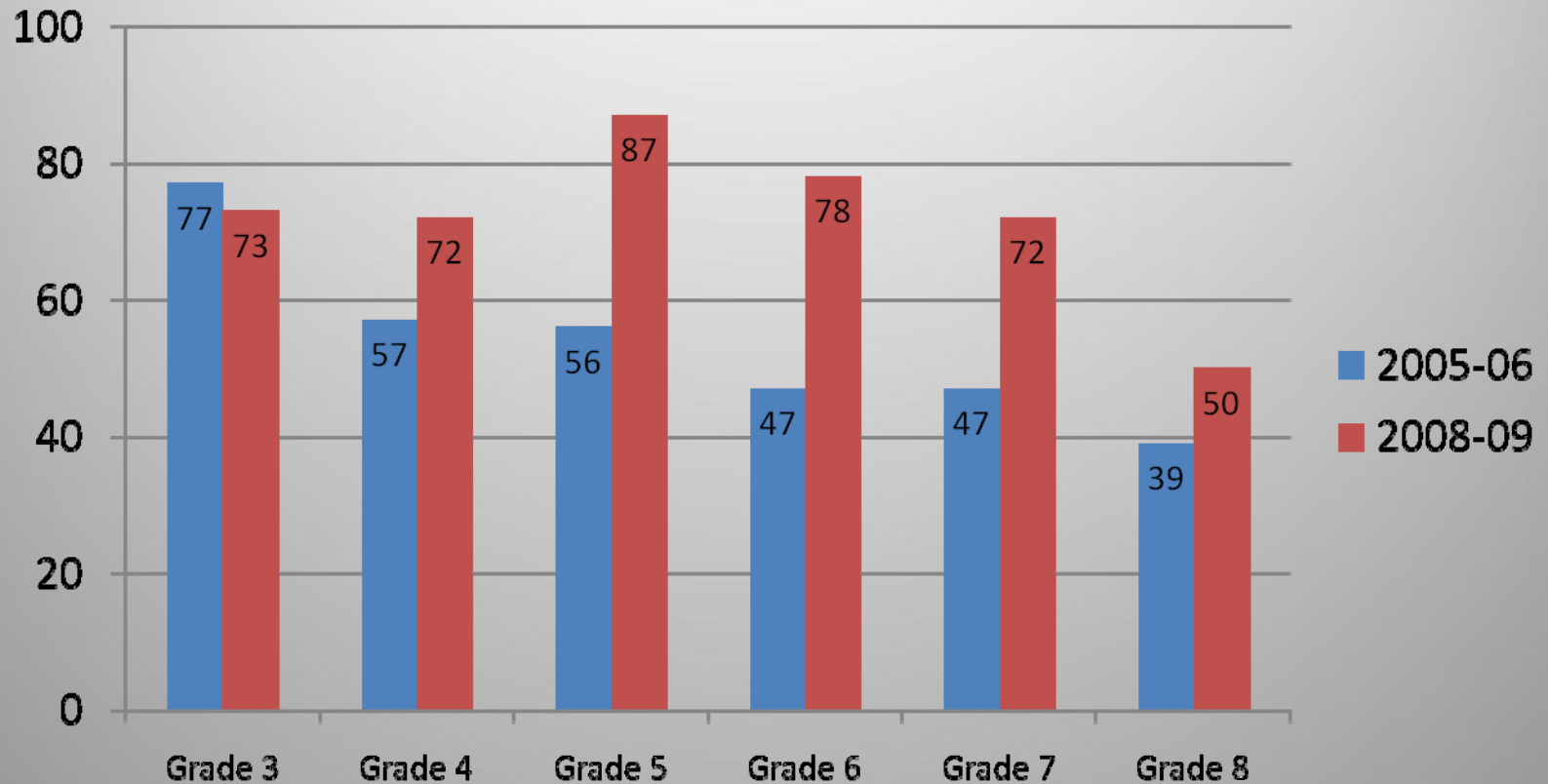
Percentage of Students Scoring in Levels 3 and 4

# ELA Comparison (2005-06 to current year)

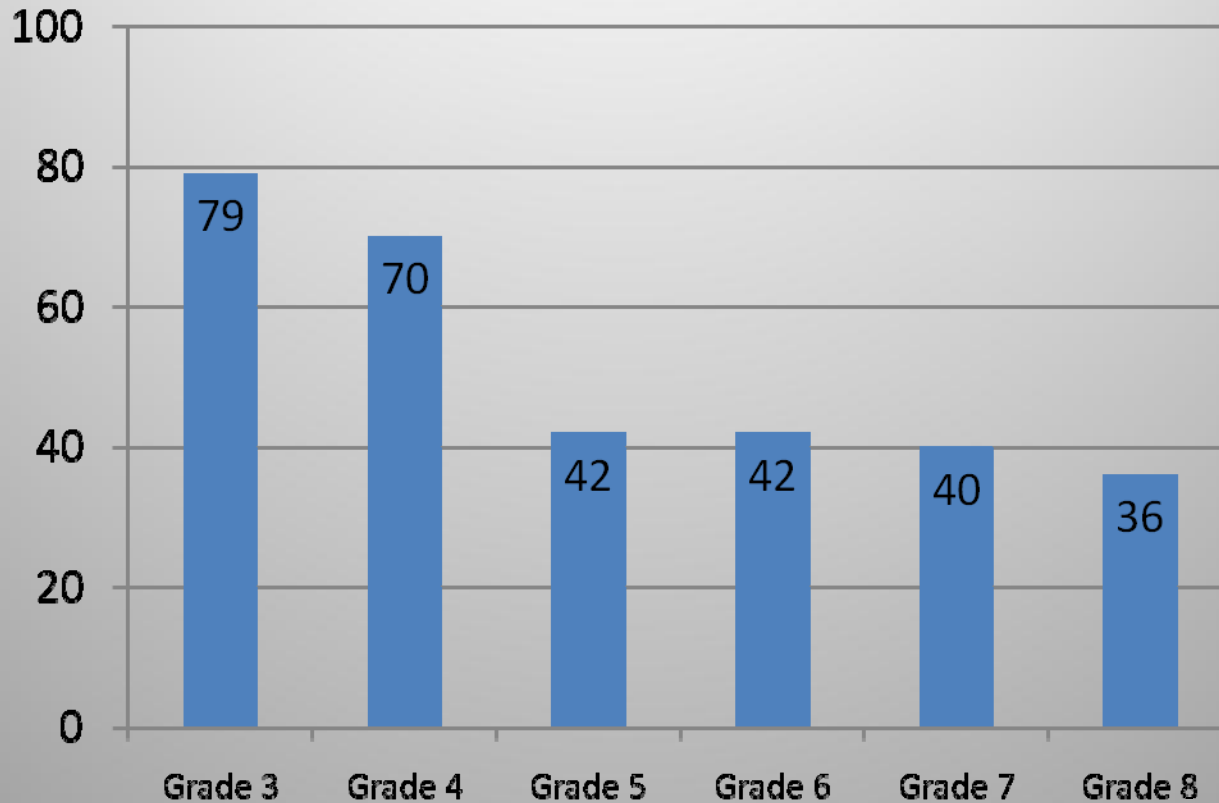
## Percentage of Students Scoring in Levels 3 and 4

# NYS Math Assessments (2005-06)

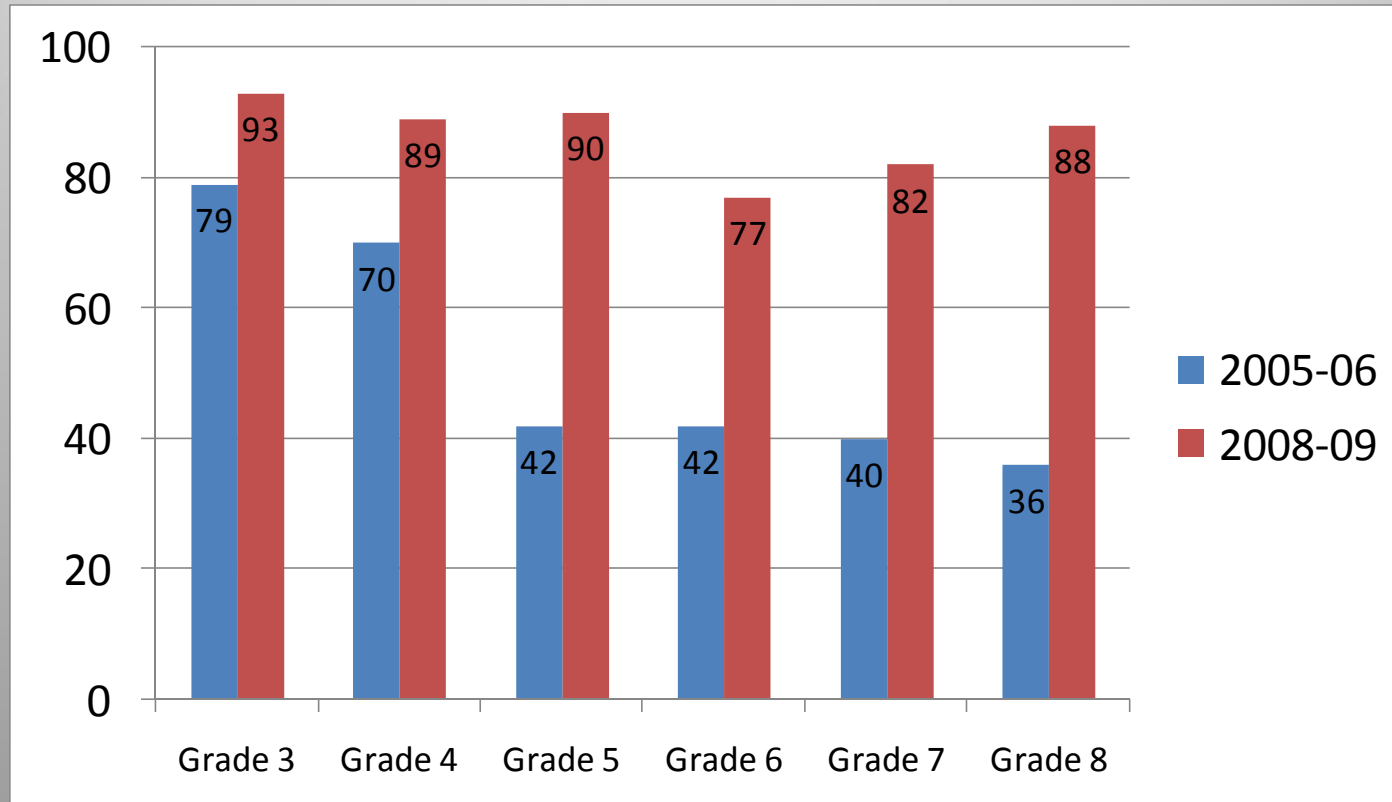
Percentage of Students Scoring in Levels 3 and 4



*Designated as a School in Need of Improvement for Secondary Math*

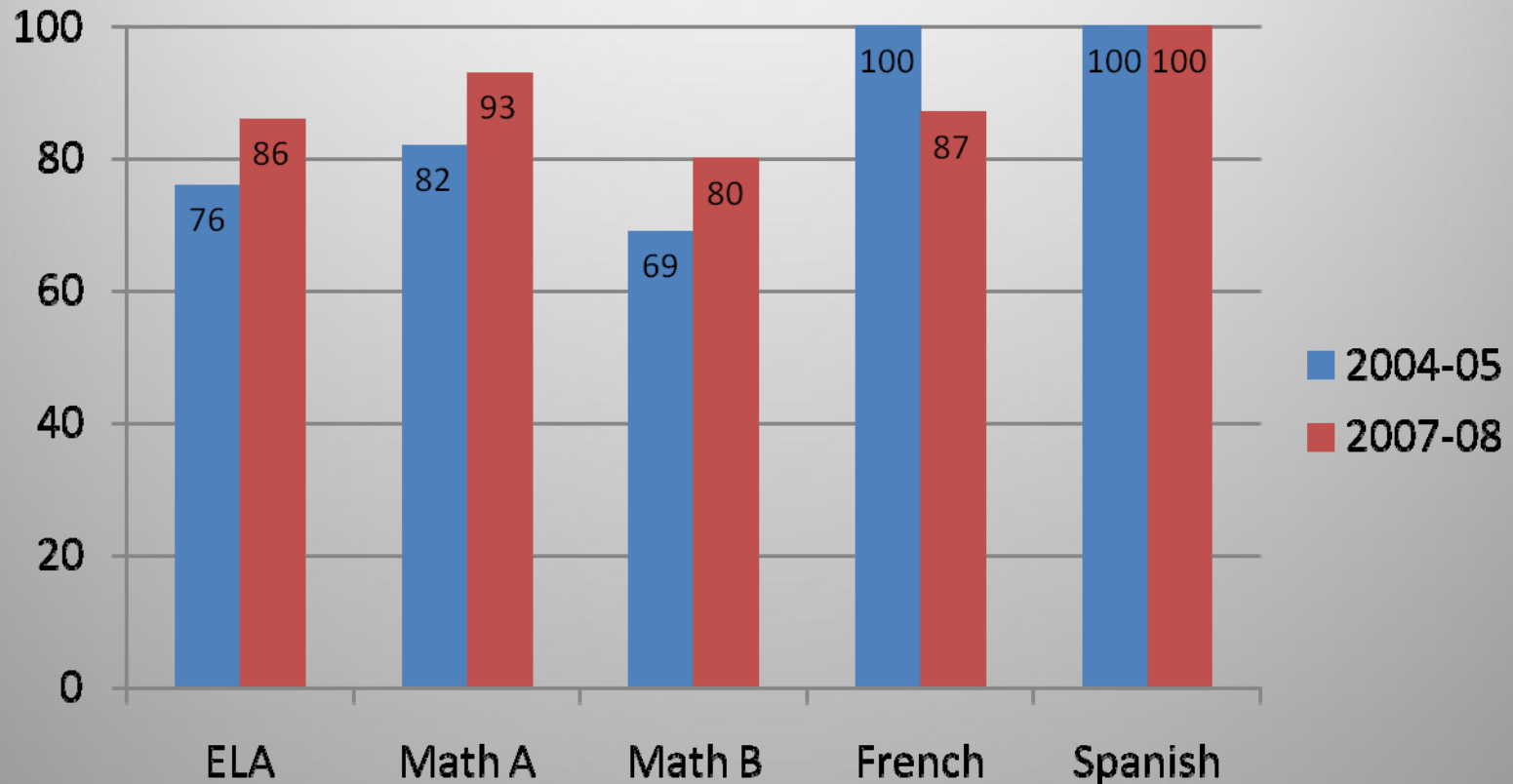
# Math Comparison (2005-06 to current year)

## Percentage of Students Scoring in Levels 3 and 4



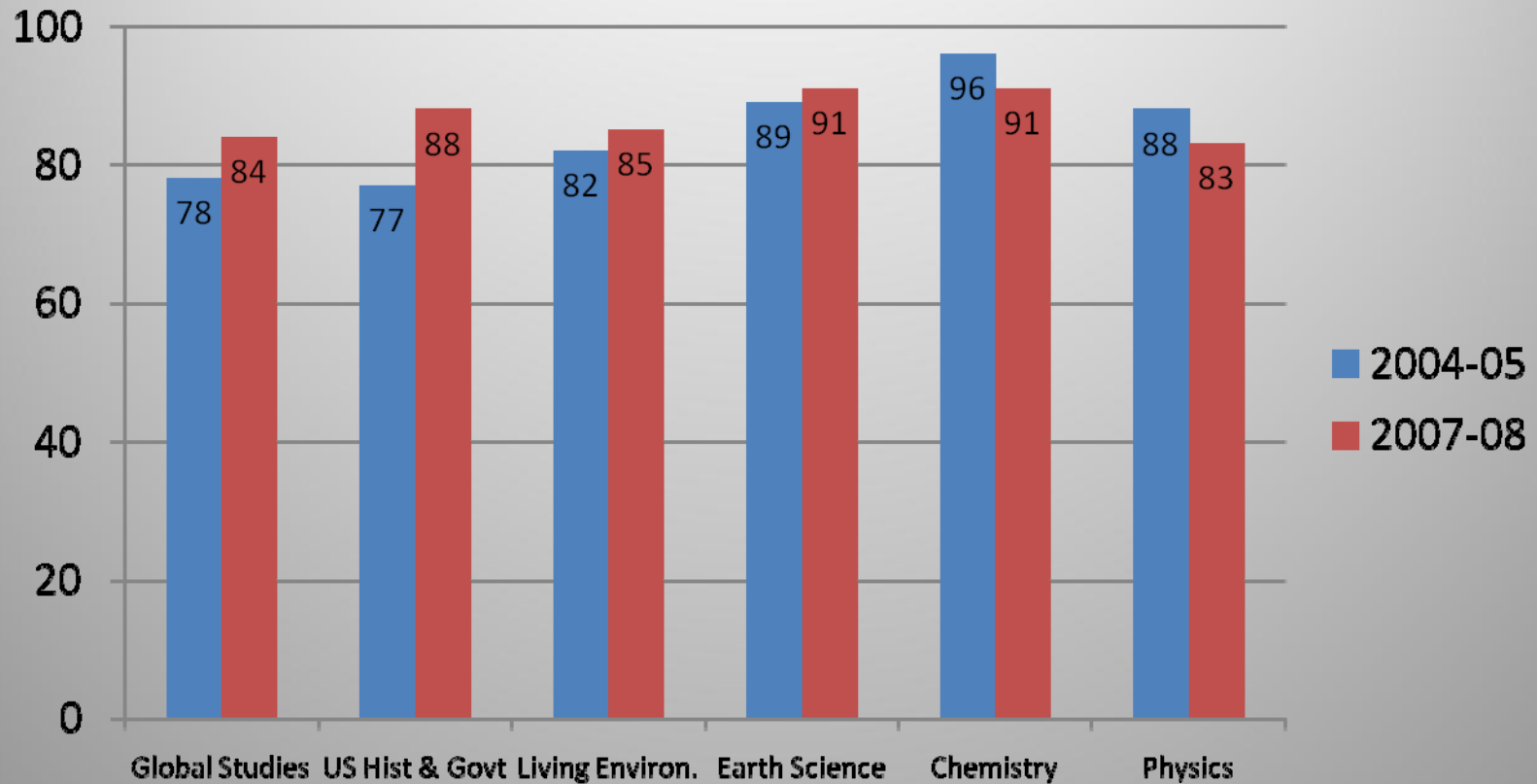

*In 2004-05, two Regents exams (ELA and Math B) resulted in less than 80% of students passing; In 2007-08, we reached our goal of 85% of students passing in all but Math B.*
