

Program Procedures

DRESS: Dress appropriately for each day's activities. All school dress policies apply at S.H.A.D.O.W.-sponsored activities too!

Students will be provided with a snack during the after school program. Please alert staff of any food allergies!



Transportation: Your transportation wishes must be written down on the student enrollment form. S.H.A.D.O.W. is a before and after-school time program open to all 7-9th graders providing homework support, study skills instruction and environmental programming and outdoor recreation. The program is free-of-charge by way of a grant from the New York State Education Department.



Enrolled S.H.A.D.O.W. students will work on projects with local scientists, teachers, and community leaders to address community environmental issues, collecting outdoor data and starting an in-depth service learning experience completing a GIS mapping project. This is an enrollment only program—you can't just drop in and participate. Applications may be picked up at the school office!

S.H.A.D.O.W. will operate 3:00—5:15 (Monday—Thursday) during the school year with special events on Fridays.

During the school year, a morning S.H.A.D.O.W. program will operate from 7-7:30 a.m. and help you improve your study and organizational skills.
